### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements for this course.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

As part of the selection criteria for this program it is highly recommended that students have completed year 10 or be of a mature age and possess sound literacy, numeracy and computer skills.

### RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL) AND CREDIT TRANSFER (CT)

### DURATION
